This list of official events has something for every licensed rifle shooter. No matter what your rifle is, if it has the capability of holding 5 rounds, then you are in the game, and we invite you to “keep'em in the X”.

This International discipline's main course of fire is known as “National Match Course” or “Across the Course”. This is THE course of fire run in the largest shooting country competitions around the world – such as USA, UK, Canada etc. Be ready for shooting from 200 to 600yards, shooting in 3 positions, and in combinations of slow fire (application) and rapid fire, or the game will beat you.....

*** * HIGH POWER RIFLE: “National Match Course” as follows.....**

Match Outline: All of the following events take place on butts ranges. Total ammo required is 58rnds.

<u>Phase 1</u>	200m Slow Fire Application,	Standing U/S	(2 sighters + 10 rounds)	10min,
<u>Phase 2</u>	200m Rapid Fire,	Sitting U/S	(2 sighters + 10 rounds)	60sec,
<u>Phase 3</u>	300m Rapid Fire,	Prone U/S	(2 sighters + 10 rounds)	70sec,
<u>Phase 4</u>	400m Slow Fire Application,	Prone U/S	(2 sighters + 20 rounds)	20min.

Note: Any of the above phases may be repeated to expand on the event.

Rifle Specification/Classes: Note: ALL rifles, of any spec, must have an operating magazine (internal or external).

Spec 1: Service - Standard Iron - Any issued iron sights service rifle in original condition – zero modifications.

Spec 2: Service - Modified Iron - As above, or faithful reproduction, modified beyond spec - service calibre.

Spec 3: Match - Match Iron - Any commercial, custom or service rifle, of any calibre, with iron sights.

Spec 4: Service - Optical - As per Specs 1 and 2, or replicated rifles, but fitted with optical sights.

Spec 5: Match - Optical - As per Spec 3 but fitted with optical sights.

Note: Sporter and Hunting rifles permitted, and are given increased times during Rapid Fire matches.

Equipment: Spotting scope, shooting mat, eye and ear protection, licence, grade card (unless new shooter) etc.

Trophies: Trophies are awarded by Rifle Class, and are presented for either outright and/or by grade (classification).
